General Chairman's Report – December 2023

Brothers and Sisters:

<u>2025 System Council 6 Convention:</u> I have begun negotiations for a venue for our next convention. The two locations currently being considered are Nashville, TN and Orlando, FL.

<u>Norfolk Southern CEO Town Hall:</u> Attended town hall meeting in McDonough, GA. During the meeting, I had breakout meetings with Labor Relations, Head of Mechanical, and Head of Engineering.

<u>Norfolk Southern Shop Meeting with management:</u> Meet with upper management and all three shifts at the Birmingham Facility. Once again, a key concern raised was the running of locomotives inside the shop. Carrier has reaffirmed that this practice is not to be done, nor is management supposed to ask a member to perform such a task. Our members are to respectfully decline to the health risk.

<u>CSX Birmingham Facility tour:</u> Planned meeting was cancelled by the carrier.

<u>New England Central Railroad</u>: Investigated member concerns regarding FRA Signal training. Held discussions with management who supplied the latest training procedures.

Norfolk Southern Lambert Point: Negotiated a temporary 4-10 agreement to address operational changes by Transportation regarding loading of coal at the point. Local Chairman Steve Old was instrumental in the completion of this temporary agreement. The Carrier is increasing the IBEW workforce to return to three shift operations. Upper management followed our recommendations and opened communications with our local chairman to receive our local's experience in making the operational change. This communication eliminated mid manager misinformation being incorrectly considered in the decision.

<u>Terminal Railway Alabama State Docks:</u> Negotiations have resulted in a tentative agreement to be presented to our members on this property for ratification. However, voting is in a holding pattern until certain portions of the language are clarified to the IBEW's satisfaction.

Vacation: December 18-29

<u>Active Claims:</u> 13 new NS cases were opened this month. 8 new CSXT cases were opened this month. In addition to normal calls and information requests, the Council is now currently handling 49 active cases. Any issue that involves disciplines/claims advanced to the Council, letter responses, medical delay documentation, RRB benefit issues, health insurance issues, etc., generate a case file with the Council.
