General Chairman's Report – June, 2022

Brothers and Sisters:

<u>National Negotiations:</u> We have been released to proceed under the Railway Labor Act! Due to the release on June 18, 2022, we are in a 30-day cooling off period. The next step will be either the appointment of a Presidential Emergency Board or the ability to strike in mid-July. In anticipation of arguments before the PEB, I have been meeting with the IO and our attorney to gather information to be presented supporting our issues.

<u>Active Claims:</u> 11 new NS cases were opened this month. 8 new CSXT cases were opened this month. In addition to normal calls and information requests, the Council is now currently handling 95 active cases. Any issue that involves disciplines/claims advanced to the Council, letter responses, medical delay documentation, RRB benefit issues, health insurance issues, etc., generate a case file with the Council.

<u>Travel:</u> Detroit – NS investigation; Albany – CSX facility tour and manager meeting.

<u>Pan Am New York Dock:</u> With CSX acquiring Pan Am, it appears that Pan Am will fall under the jurisdiction of the System Council #6. Along with SC7, who currently represents the independent Pan Am, we have been negotiating New York Dock protections for the merger.
